Authority and Responsibilities

As authorized under RCW 35.63 and Ridgefield Municipal Code (RMC) 2.12, the Planning Commission consists of seven members appointed by the mayor and confirmed by the council to serve four year terms. Eligible members must reside within the corporate limits of the City of Ridgefield.

The Planning Commission acts as a research and fact finding agency of the City Ridgefield and serves in an advisory capacity to the city council and mayor. Therefore, the Planning Commission may:

- 1. Make such surveys, analyses, researches and reports as are required of it by the ordinances of the city and as are requested by the council or mayor;
- 2. Make inquiries, investigations, and conduct such hearings as may be necessary as to enable it to make recommendations from time to time to the council as to the best methods of conservation, utilization, planning and development within the city;
- 3. Participate in the development or update of the Comprehensive Plan and Development Code, and monitor implementation to ensure that the City achieves its land use and community livability goals; and
- 4. Review, consider public input and make recommendations to Council regarding major planned developments, mixed use developments and subarea plans.
