ABOUT PARKS BOARD

The Parks Board is a seven-member board who advise the City Council on parks planning, parks acquisition, operations and maintenance within the current and future city limits of Ridgefield.

Parks Board meets at 6:30 PM on the second Wednesday of each month.

The youth position on the Parks Board will serve a two-year term and have the same rights and responsibilities as adult members.



REQUIREMENTS

- Be 14-17 years of age.
- Reside within the city limits of Ridgefield.
- Ability to attend and participate in Parks Board meetings.
- Commit to 4-6 hours each month outside of meetings for training, learning and preparation.
- Desire to make a positive difference for youth and represent youth opinions and ideas.
