



E-Bikes and E-Scooters

Where can I ride?

***Powers over 20 mph:** If you have a motorized cycle that powers over 20 mph, the rider must be **16 or older**.

Powers over 28 mph: If you have a motorized cycle that powers over 28 mph, it is legally classified as a motorcycle and must be:

- Registered with the WA Department of Motor Vehicles
- Driven by someone with a valid driver's license, possibly a motorcycle endorsement.

Electric Motorcycles: A motorized cycle that has A) a motor that exceeds 750 watts, B) a motor that powers over 28 mph, or C) does not have pedals that move and propel the bike, is legally a motorcycle. **All laws that apply to gas-powered motorcycles also apply to electric motorcycles.**

Ride Safe, Stay Safe

E-bike and E-scooter operators must follow the rules of the road and avoid riding in a way that endangers or inhibits others.

- Stop at STOP signs.
- Yield to pedestrians in crosswalks and on sidewalks.
- Obey posted speed limits.
- Wear a helmet with a chin strap.
- Avoid weaving in and out of traffic and pay close attention to your surroundings.
