CEMETERY BOOSTER PUMP STATION AND NORTHRIDGE WATER MAIN PROJECT ENGINEER'S ESTIMATE SCHEDULE A: \$300,000 SCHEDULE B: \$196,000

Sealed Proposals will be received by the undersigned at the City of Ridgefield, 230 Pioneer Street, Ridgefield, Washington 98642, up to 11:00 a.m.; local time on Thursday, March 15, 2018, for furnishing the necessary labor, materials, equipment, tools, and guarantees thereof to construct Cemetery Booster Pump Station and Northridge Water Main Project.

This Project provides for the following two schedules of work:

Schedule A – Cemetery Booster Pump Station – Demolish existing water booster pump station and construct new pump station, site piping, sitework, site restoration, electrical, telemetry, and controls.

Schedule B – Northridge Water Main – Construct 785 lf 4-inch water main, 70 lf 8-inch water main, water services, PRV station, two bored water services, and appurtenances along Northridge Drive and the cemetery.

The Work shall be substantially complete within 60 working days after the commencement date stated in the Notice to Proceed. All bidding and construction is to be performed in compliance with the Contract Provisions and Contract Plans for this project and any addenda issued thereto that are on file at the office of the City Clerk, City Hall, Washington.

The Proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud shortly after the time and date stated above. Proposals are to be submitted only on the form provided with the Bid Documents. All Proposals must be accompanied by a certified check, cashiers check, money order, or Proposal bond payable to the “City of Ridgefield” and in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount bid.

The City of Ridgefield expressly reserves the right to reject any or all Proposals and to waive minor irregularities or informalities and to Award the Project to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder as it best serves the interests of the City.
