Chili Challenge Rules:

1. The challenge is open to anyone but preference will be given to those who live or operate a business in the 98642 zip code area.
2. Chili must be prepared in a commercial kitchen.
3. The challenge is limited to a maximum of 6 entrants; on a first come, first accepted basis.
4. Cook your best chili recipe and bring equipment to keep it at a safe temperature on event day. Provide sanitary conditions during preparation of chili and on serving day.
5. Bring a table, a 25 ft. 3 prong extension cord, a table cloth (if you'd like) and your own cooking utensils for stirring and serving.
6. The following items will be provided: sample cups for judging, spoons and napkins.
7. The challenge will be judged by the general public with tasting between 11AM-1PM.
8. You may bring chili for judging only, or you may choose to bring extra for sales following the judging. If you choose to sell bowls of chili, you are responsible for providing the bowls and for all sales. A commercial kitchen is available in the building ONLY to keep chili warm (not for preparations on the day of the event). If you will need space, please include that information on the application form.
9. Use your best judgment regarding spice level; not all judges like a lot of heat.
10. Do not offer any condiments for judging such as cheese, sour cream, onions, etc. Judging will be CHILI only. A condiment bar will be available for any chili that you choose to sell.
