Invitation to Bid

P21012: Storm Facility Rehabilitation

The City of Ridgefield is seeking bids from highly qualified contractors to provide all labor, supplies, equipment, materials for the rehabilitation of the following stormwater facilities: Falcon Drive Facility, the existing Reiman Rd Facility, the existing Lark and Heron Drive Facility, and the existing Heron Drive and 18th Place Facility in the Bellwood Heights Subdivision and the 19th Place Facility. Work shall include mobilization, preparation, clearing, grading, disposal of materials, and other work, all in accordance with the attached Contract Plans, these Contract Provisions, and the Standard Specifications. The scope of work at each facility generally includes rehabilitation of the biofiltration swales and cleaning of structures at each facility to get them back to their as-built condition following original construction and removing the accumulated sediment from the Heron/18th pond and regrading to get it back to its as-built condition. As-built plan sheets from the Subdivision construction are attached for reference.

The Work shall be fully complete no later than September 17, 2021. Work may not commence any earlier than July 2021 without approval of the Project Manager.

Bid packages may be picked up at J2 Blue Print Supply Co, located at 8100 NE St. Johns Road, Suite B101, Vancouver, Washington. The City of Ridgefield places great importance on the integrity and accuracy of the official plan holders list. Therefore each bidder will be required to register at the following email address: Bid@j2b.com. Once registered, bidders will receive a username login, password and download rights. Users may then download bid documents from the J2 plan center. Users will be notified by email containing a link which will provide all project updates and addenda. No other plan centers are authorized to disseminate bid packages. The fees for obtaining a bid package are non-refundable. Registration as a plan holder is included with the purchase of a bid package, and is required to obtain Contract Addenda.

All project specific questions, requests for substitutions, or requests for clarification must be sent to Julia Denton, Procurement Specialist, via email to Bids@ridgefieldwa.us and be received by 4:00 p.m. on **Thursday, May 20, 2021**. Incomplete or late inquiries may not be considered.

Sealed bids must be received by the City no later than 3:00 PM (Pacific Time) **Tuesday, June 1, 2021**. Submissions received after the specified time will not be accepted. The City of Ridgefield is not responsible for delays in delivery. Official delivery time shall be documented by City affixed time/date stamp.
